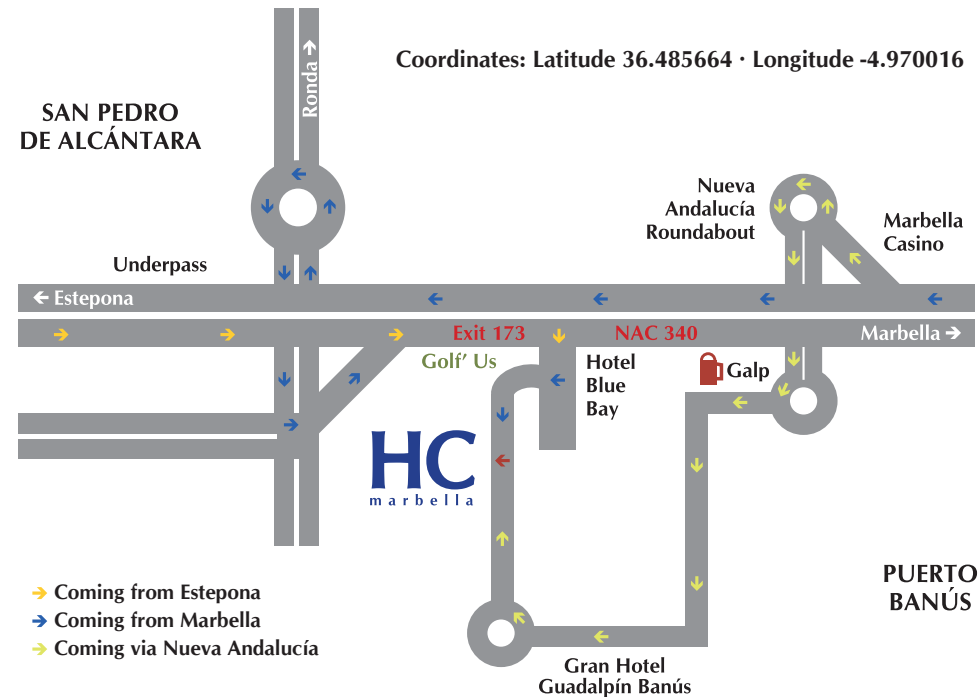

Pigmented Lesions and Melanoma

Early detection of melanoma is essential to improve the prognosis.

In its early stages, melanoma can be successfully removed and monitored by regular skin screenings. In fact, survival rates can exceed 90 percent to 95 percent in early stage melanoma. However, in its most advanced stages, melanoma can be deadly. Survival rates drop to less than 20 percent when melanoma has spread to other organs. Increase your chances of catching melanoma early by carefully examining your skin once a month.

Non-Melanoma, Skin Cancer and Dermatology Surgery



Basal Cell Carcinoma is a locally destructive malignancy. They are the most common type of skin cancer and the majority of them are located on the head and neck. UV exposure is the most common risk factor. The surgical treatment is one of the best option.

Squamous Cell Carcinoma is the second most common skin cancer. It usually appears in sun exposed areas. **Actinic queratosis** are their precursor lesions. Late detect ion may be complicated by more advanced disease and involvement of regional lymphatics.
