Health Screening for the early detection of skin cancer

Indicated for people with:

Multiple moles or nevi

History of burns in childhood or adolescence

Chronic sun exposure (people who have their sport or work outdoors)

Antecedents of melanoma in their relatives

History of a previous skin cancer

Patients immunosuppressed either by treatment or another cause

People with fair skin, blond or red hair, low photo types (who always burn, and do not tan)





Anyone can have a skin cancer and should be consulted if:

There are changes in a previous mole or nevus (in shape, size, color, itching, ...)

Appearance of a mole or previous skin lesion that previously did not exist

Small scales or crusts that do not heal that last more than 1 month on the skin

Appearance of a fast growing growth
