

#### Correct use of the mask





Hands should be washed thoroughly with soap and water or hydroalcoholic solution.

# How to place it



Place it touching only the outer straps, adjusting it well, covering the nose, mouth and chin.

## How to withdraw it



Remove without touching the front, taking it only from the outer tapes.

# How to dispose of it



If it is disposable, put it in a waterproof bag and throw it away. Then wash your hands well.

## 5 How to wash it



If it is reusable, follow the manufacturer's instructions regarding care and washing.

### Respiratory label compliance

The use of a mask must be accompanied by compliance with other preventive measures: frequent hand washing, coughing or sneezing into the elbow or disposable tissue, throwing the disposable tissues in the trash and washing your hands afterwards, not touching your eyes, nose or mouth, do not leave home if you have symptoms, respect the social distance of 2 m.

## **Types** of masks



### Hygienic

They can serve **not to spread.** 

They **do not protect** those who carry them from contagion.

They can be either reusable or disposable.

Not approved.



#### Surgical

They serve **not to spread.** 

They **do not protect** those who carry them from contagion.

They are disposable.

### FFP1 without exhalation valve

They serve **not to spread.** 

They **do not protect** those who carry them from contagion.

Protective equipment with minimal filtration.

### FFP2 without exhalation valve

They serve **not to spread.** 

They **do protect** those who carry them from contagion.

Protective equipment.

Conforming to regulations.



## FFP2 with FFP3 exhalation valve

They do not serve to not infect.

They **do protect** those who carry them from contagion.

Protective equipment.
